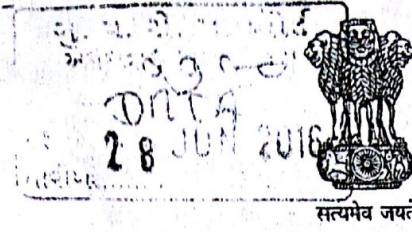

Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993.

No. KP/24 of 2016/PRR/1194/565/KH:- In exercise of the powers confers by section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj. 18 of 1993) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Social Welfare Inspector (Junior Grade), Class III, in the superior Panchayat Service, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Social Welfare Inspector (Junior Grade), Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service Recruitment Rules, 2016.
2. Appointment to the post of Social Welfare Inspector (Junior Grade), Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service, shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
 - (a) not be less than 21 years and not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Panchayat Department in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayats Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1998.

- (b) possess a Bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other education institution recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, and
- (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The Provisions of rule 10A of the Gujarat Panchayats Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the departmental examination [and an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both] in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
