No. GS/97-13-CRR-1096-2213/G.2 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title, commencement and application:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Gujarat Civil Services (Reservation of Posts for Women) Rules, 1997.
- (2) They shall come into force at once.
- (3) They shall apply to the filling up of posts by direct recruitment.
- 2. Reservation of Posts for Women:- Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules or orders relating to recruitment to public services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State-
 - (a) There shall be reserved in favour of women belonging to the Scheduled Castes thirty percent of the posts reserved in favour of such Castes;
 - (b) there shall be reserved in favour of women belonging to the Scheduled Tribes thirty percent of the posts reserved in favour of such Tribes;
 - (c) There shall be reserved in favour of women belonging to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes thirty percent of the posts reserved in favour of such classes;

and

(d) there shall be reserved in favour of women thirty percent of the posts not being posts reserved in favour of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Socially and Educationally Backward Classes.

Explanation: For the purposes of these rules.-

- (a) "Scheduled Castes" means such castes, races or tribes or parts of groups within such castes, races or tribes as are deemed to be Scheduled Castes in relation to the State of Gujarat under Article 341 of the Constitution of India.
- (b) "Scheduled Tribes" means such tribes or tribal communities or parts of or groups within such tribes or tribal communities as are deemed to be Scheduled or tribal communities as are deemed to be Scheduled Tribes in relation to the State of Gujarat under Article 342 of the Constitution.

"Socially and Educationally Backward Class" means such castes, classes or groups as are determined by the State Government as Socially and Educationally Backward Class under Government Resolution, Labour, Social Welfare and Tribal Development Department No: BCR-10734-H, dated the 1st April, 1978, as amended from time to time. ្រីដីព្រះ ស្រី ស្រី ស្រី ស្រី ស្រី ស្រី ស្រី និង នេះដី ស្រី ស្រី គឺមាន
