GUJARAT PANCHAYATS ACT, 1993

No. KP/41 of 2013/PRR/102013/1846-KH.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj.18 of 1993) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Compounder, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service, namely :-

- These rules may be called the Compounder, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service 1. Recruitment Rules, 2013.
- Appointment to the post of Compounder, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service shall be made 2. by direct selection.
- To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall -3.
- (a) not be more than 30 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate, who is already in the Gujarat Panchayats Service in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayat Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess -

(i) a bachelor's degree in Pharmacy obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government;

OR

- (ii) a diploma in Pharmacy obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and having about two years experience in dispensing the medicines in hospitals or dispensaries;
- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules, a candidate selected by direct recruitment under rule 3 shall be appointed on contract basis for five years on such terms and conditions as prescribed in Government Notification, Panchayat, Rural Housing and Rural Development Department No. KP-12-2011-PRR-102010-2530-D, dated the 15th June, 2011.
- 5. A candidate appointed under rule 3 shall be given the prescribed pay scale of the post of Compounder after completion of contractual period on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contract basis.
- 6. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 above shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to pass the CCC examination for computer knowledge as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 7. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall, after regular appointment, be required to pass an examination of Hindi or Gujarati or both, as the case may be, in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 8. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
- 9. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to get himself registered with the Gujarat Pharmacy Council in accordance with the provisions of the Pharmacy Act 1948 at the time of his application for direct selection, if he is not so registered.
- 10. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government from time to time.
