## CCETITUTION INDIA

No. GS-86-(18)-RES-1086-1728-G.2: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Gujarat Civil Services (Reservation of Vacancies for Ex-servicemen in Class III and Class IV posts and service) Rules, 1975, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Gujarat Civil Services (Reservation of vacancies for ex-servicemen in Glass III and Glass IV posts and service)(Amendment) Rules, 1987.
- 2. In the Gujarat Civil Services (Reservation of vacancies for ex-servicemen in Class III and Class IV posts and service) Rules, 1975, (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules"), in rule 6, after sub-rule (2), the following sub-rules shall be inserted, namely:
  - in Class III posts, a matriculate Ex-servicemen (which term includes an ex-servicemen, who has obtained the Indian Army Special Certificate of Education or the corresponding certificate in the Navy or the Air Force), who has put in not less than 15 years' service in the Armod Forces of the Union may be considered eligible for appointment to the posts for which the essential educational qualification prescribed is graduation and where -
  - (a) work experience of technical or professional
  - (b) though non-technical professional work exterience is prescribed as essential yet the appointing authority is satisfied that the ex-servicemen is expected to perform the duties of the post by undergoing on the job training for a short duration.

(4) For appointment to any reserved vacancies in Class III and Class IV posts, where the prescribed minimum educational qualification is matriculation, the appointing authority may, at his discretion, relax the minimum educaticnal qualifications in favour of ex-servicemen who has passed the Indian Army Class I Examination or its equivalent examination in the Mayy or the Air Force, and who has put in atleast 15 years' service in the Armed Forces of the Union and is otherwise considered fit to hold the post, in view of his experience and other qualifications."

In the said rules, after rule 6, the following rule 3• shall be insorted, namely :-

"64. Lower standard for selection :- In the case of direct recruitment, if sufficient number of candidates belonging to the ex-servicemen is not available on the basis of general standard to fill all the vacancies reserved for them, candidates belonging to the category of ex-servicemen may be selected under a relaxed standard of selection to take up the deficiency in the reserved quota subject to the condition that such relaxation will not affect the level of of performance by such candidates."
