Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993.

No. KP/01 of 2019/PRR/1194/383/KH:- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj. 18 of 1993) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Live Stock Inspector, Class III in the Superior Panchayat Service, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Live Stock Inspector, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service, Recruitment Rules, 2018.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Live Stock Inspector, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service, shall be made by direct selection.
- 3.. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
 - (a) not be less than 18 years and not be more than 33 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of

Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the panchayat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayats Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998;

(b) have passed,-

- (i) Secondary school Certificate Examination conducted by the Secondary/Higher Secondary Education Board with English as one of the subjects or possess an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government; and
- (ii) (a) successfully at least one year duration the pre-service Live Stock Inspector course recognized by the Government of Gujarat; or
- (b) three years diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry or Diploma in Animal Husbandry obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Agriculture or Veterinary University Act and recognized by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).
- (c) Possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;
- (d) Possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

4. The provisions of rule 10A of the Gujarat Panchayats Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
