#### GUJARAT PANCHAYATS ACT, 1993.

No. KP/38 of 2013/PRR/102013/1858-KH.—: In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993, (Guj.18 of 1993) the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Staff Nurse, Class III, in Superior Panchayat Service, namely:

- 1. These rules may be called the Staff Nurse, Class III in Superior Panchayat Service Recruitment Rules, 2013.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Staff Nurse, Class III, in Superior Panchayat Service shall be made by direct selection.
- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall -
  - (a) not be more than 40 years of age \*

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favoure of a candidate-

(i) who is already in the services of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

or

(ii) who is already in the services of the panchayats in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayats services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998;

- (b) possess -
  - (i) a degree of post basic B.Sc. (Nursing) obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed to be a deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and recognized by Indian Nursing Council; or
  - a Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and recognized by Indian Nursing Council or the Gujarat Nursing Council;
  - (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:
  - (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

    Provided that a candidate who have worked for not less than ten years in the cadre of Auxiliary Nurse Midwife or Female Health worker in the subordinate service of the Government and / or in the superior panchayat service of the Panchayat and who possesses the qualification as prescribed in clause (b) of rule 3, may be also eligible for appointment to the post mentioned in rule 2 above.
- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules, a candidate selected by direct recruitment under rule 3 shall be appointed on contract basis for five years on such terms and conditions as prescribed in Government Notification, Panchayats, Rural Housing and Rural Development Department, No. KP-12-2011-PRR-102010-2530-D, dated the 15th June, 2011.
- 5. A candidate appointed under rule 3 shall be given the prescribed pay scale of the post of Staff Nurse after completion of contractual period on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contract basis.
- 6. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to pass the CCC examination for computer knowledge as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 7. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule-3 shall, after regular appointment, be required to pass an examination of Hindi or Guajrati or both, as the case may be, in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 8. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
- 9. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to get himself registered with the Gujarat Nursing Council under the Gujarat Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act, 1968 (Guj. 24 of 1968) at the time of his application for direct selection, if he is not so registered.
- 10. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
