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## NOTIFICATION

No. KP/08 of 2014/PRR/102014/93/KH:- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 227 read with sub-section (5) of section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj. 18 of 1993) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Additional Assistant Engineer (Civil), Class III, in Superior Panchayats Service, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Additional Assistant Engineer (Civil), Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service Recruitment Rules, 2014.
2. Appointment to the post of Additional Assistant Engineer (Civil), Class III, in the Superior Panchayats Service shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall –

(a) not be less than 18 years and not be more than 28 years of age :

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the Gujarat Panchayats service in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayats Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1998;

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Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess a Diploma in Civil Engineering obtained from Technical Examination Board or any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government;

(c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.


7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the departmental examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
